# Foundations for our future

Stakeholder briefing: December 2024

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This stakeholder briefing provides an update on progress against our strategic investment projects between October and December 2024.

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# Highlights summary

- Enabling works are progressing for the multi-storey car park at CRH
- The new Learning and Development Centre is nearing completion
- The design phase for the clinical build at Calderdale Royal is progressing - with the aid of immersive technology



# Multi-storey car park

- Works are underway (pictured right) on the site of the new multi-storey car park at Calderdale Royal including to drainage and electrical services. Activity will move towards the Dudwell Lane entrance to the site from this month.
- Patients and visitors are still able to park on site using the car parks via the Godfrey Road entrances
- For staff we have put in place park and ride facilities from the Eureka! overflow car park and at Cedar Court Hotel (Ainley Top). This service is operating well and we have made some changes to the service in line with what staff and the public have been telling us, including returning the Council's High Street Car Park for public use
- The multi-storey car park will free up space to allow for future development of the new clinical building and ward areas and significantly improve car parking provision at Calderdale Royal Hospital for patients, visitors and staff



# Learning and Development Centre

Most of the building is now complete. The external cladding panel installation is nearing completion and the internal fit out, including decor, floor coverings, internal doors and suspended ceilings are nearing completion.

Groundworks are progressing well and all drains are now installed around the perimeter of the building. Kerb installation is due to commence soon, alongside hard and soft landscaping and tidying of the site. The revised completion is early 2025.

**Internal areas are designed to provide:**

- Simulation teaching suites
- Flexible spaces for individual and group learning
- Library – providing flexible areas and all latest clinical journals and papers
- Kitchen facilities and rest areas

**External areas are designed to provide:**

- A building that will complement the existing surroundings
- Landscaped garden and planting to encourage wildlife
- Outdoor rest areas



# Calderdale Royal Hospital

Alongside our construction partners, Laing O'Rourke, we have started to progress the design stage of the new clinical building and A&E at Calderdale Royal Hospital.

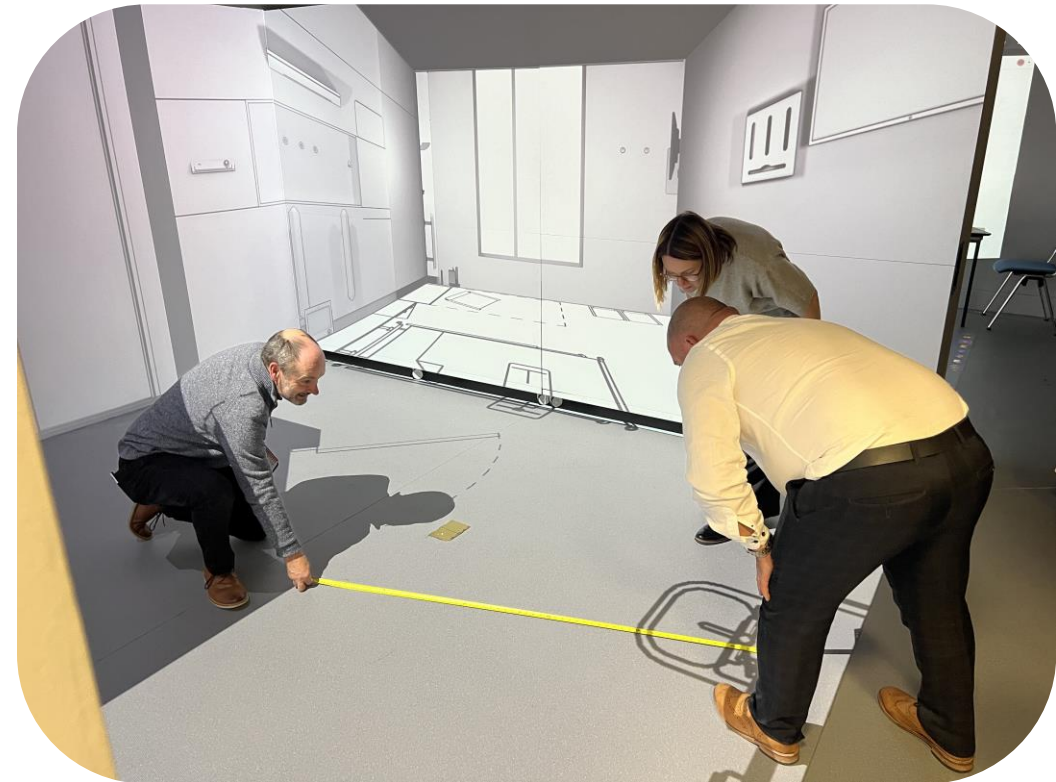
The project will deliver new adult's and children's accident and emergency departments with resuscitation bays and assessment rooms, as well as new inpatient wards.

- Community Bladder and Bowel Service
- Community Lymphoedema Service

# Huddersfield Community Diagnostic Centre

Construction on the second building on the University of Huddersfield's National Health Innovation Campus (NHIC) has officially begun, [following a groundbreaking ceremony at the site in the town centre.](#)

The ground floor of the Emily Siddon Building will host our second Community Diagnostic Centre (CDC). It is expected to open in early 2026.



In November, a small number of colleagues were invited to join Karin Smyth MP, Minister of State for Health (Secondary Care), on her visit to the NHIC, during which the Minister was briefed on the plans for the new CDC.
