## **Highlights summary**



- Work continues to plan for the new multi-storey car park at Calderdale Royal
- We expect to be able to announce the opening date for the new A&E at Huddersfield Royal Infirmary in the coming weeks
- A construction partner has been announced for the clinical build at Calderdale Royal















## **Huddersfield Royal Infirmary A&E**

- As part of the extensive quality and safety checks on the new A&E at Huddersfield Royal Infirmary, we identified a concern with the jointing compound used in the water pipework late last year.
- We have been working closely with the building contractors to undertake the remedial measures required.
- We have made good progress on the remedial works and expect to be able to announce an opening date in the coming weeks







### **CRH Car Park**

- Work is underway to build a new, multi-storey car park at Calderdale Royal Hospital
- Ground enabling works on the car park site are due to commence from July 2024
- The multi-storey car park will free up space to allow for future development of the new clinical building and ward areas
- The new car park will also significantly improve car parking provision at Calderdale Royal Hospital for patients, visitors and staff





## **Learning and Development Centre**



Demolition is complete, the site has been levelled and construction has commenced.

The Learning and Development centre is being installed as a modular build, and will be crane-lifted onto site after Easter.

A groundbreaking ceremony was held to celebrate the start of construction on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2024, and was attended by representatives from both CHFT and

Darwin Group.













## Internal areas are designed to provide:

- Simulation teaching suites
- Flexible spaces for individual and group learning
- Library providing flexible areas and all latest clinical journals and papers
- Kitchen facilities and rest areas

# External areas are designed to provide:

- A building that will complement the existing surroundings
- Landscaped garden and planting to encourage wildlife
- Outdoor rest areas







## **Calderdale Royal Hospital**



A construction partner for the CRH clinical build has been appointed. We look forward to publicly announcing the winning bidder in the coming weeks.



















## **Community Diagnostic Centres**

Community Diagnostic Centres are part of a national programme to increase access to diagnostic tests, such as CT scanning, phlebotomy, and cardio-respiratory services in the community.

#### Halifax

- Construction is underway for the Community Diagnostic Centre at Broad Street Plaza and it is due to open in June 2024 (artistic impressions, right, show designs for the atrium area)
- An increased number of diagnostic tests (ECG, ultrasound and phlebotomy) have been provided within the existing footprint since December 2023

#### Huddersfield

 The planning permission application has been submitted for the Huddersfield Community Diagnostic Centre (due to open in 2026), which will be situated on the University of Huddersfield Campus
